- Create a business model that considers your target market segments, your value proposition & more
- Identify possible small business funding opportunities

After the training, at 12:30PM, meet at the new bulk water filling station for an optional demonstration.

**Both licensed and unlicensed water haulers, along with those interested in water hauling services, are welcome.**

The City of Durango now has two bulk water filling stations with an estimated discharge of 80 gpm, located at 550 S Camino del Rio. The stations provide bulk water sales to the public, commercial users, and contractors. Customers will need to adapt to the standard 2" quick connect connection installed on the filling stations.
