Level 1 Low	≥ 70% Usable Storage	<p>Irrigation is permitted only between 9 PM – 9 AM</p> <p>Gardens (edible and ornamental) may be hand watered using a hose or drip irrigation at any time.</p>
Level 2 Moderate	≥ 50% Usable Storage	<p>Irrigation permitted only between 9 PM to 9 AM based upon address</p> <p>Odd numbered addresses may irrigate on odd numbered calendar days while even numbered address may irrigate on even numbered days</p> <p>Irrigation is permitted Monday – Friday Only. Weekend watering is prohibited.</p> <p>Gardens (edible and ornamental) may be hand watered using a hose or drip irrigation at any time.</p>
Level 3 Serious	≥ 40% Usable Storage	<p>Irrigation permitted only between 9 PM to 9 AM based upon address</p> <p>Irrigation is permitted Monday or Thursday only depending on address. Watering on other days is prohibited.</p> <p>Gardens (edible and ornamental) may be hand watered using a hose or drip irrigation at any time.</p>
Level 4 Severe	≥ 30% Usable Storage	Irrigation of all landscape elements is prohibited, including gardens (edible and ornamental).

Usable Storage is the amount of reservoir storage available to the District in Hatcher, Stevens, Pagosa, Village and Forest.
